ASSISTANT PROFESSOR IN READING/LITERACY INSTRUCTION

DEPARTMENT:

The College of Education and the Florida Center for Reading Research (FCRR) at Florida State University seek an energetic scholar in the area of reading/literacy for an assistant professor tenure-earning position to start in Fall 2017. The position will involve teaching, research, and service in the School of Teacher Education, and will be made jointly with FCRR. Affiliation with FCRR carries a reduced teaching assignment with correspondingly high expectations for research. Applicants with expertise and research interests in school-based reading instruction/intervention are encouraged to apply. We are particularly interested in scholars who study diverse populations of learners in middle and secondary school settings, however strong candidates studying other populations will certainly be considered.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

Applicants will be expected to maintain a rigorous grant writing and research program related to reading/literacy, teach masters and doctoral level classes in the School of Teacher Education, advise masters and doctoral students, and participate in university governance.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Earned Ph.D. in an education or related field with an emphasis on reading/literacy instruction/intervention with the ability and experiences needed to teach within a teacher licensure program. Candidates should demonstrate a strong commitment to graduate teaching and advising; evidence of scholarly productivity and the potential to develop an independent research program; and the ability to seek federal funding to support research activities.

If qualified and interested in a specific job opening as advertised, apply to Florida State University at <https://jobs.fsu.edu>. Applicants are required to complete the online application with all applicable information. Applications must include all work history up to ten years, and all education details even if attaching a resume. In addition to the application and vita/resume, a statement of research interests, representative publications, and 3 letters of recommendations are also required.
