He is currently serving as Director of Psychometric Services in the Office of Assessment at the Florida Department of Education. Under his leadership, Dr. Binici's team plays an integral part in establishing the scales and scores for Florida's large-scale assessment programs, such as the Florida Comprehensive Assessment Test 2.0 and Florida Standards Assessments. Dr. Binici served as President of the Florida Educational Research Association (FERA) and played a critical role in verifying that FERA addressed issues at stake for university faculty and graduate researchers, as well as assessment experts from school districts and the Florida Department of Education. Since the spring of 2007, Dr. Binici has been teaching graduate-level courses in the Measurement and Statistics program at the Florida State University.
