HOW TO APPLY

Review of candidates will begin on September 15, 2021 and will continue until filled. Interested candidates should submit an online application at jobs.fsu.edu. Applicants are required to complete FSU's online application, providing all educational details, work history, and a curriculum vitae. Applicants should also include a letter of application, names of three references with contact information, and a statement of teaching interests that includes a philosophy of preparing social studies teachers. Transcripts and three written letters of recommendation will be required of candidates selected for a campus interview.
