2017 Counselor Education Program Outcomes

Currently, there are 39 students enrolled in the M.S./Ed.S. Counselor Education program at Florida State University. Of these, 29 are majoring in Mental Health Counseling and 10 are majoring in Career Counseling. During 2017, the program graduated 25 students (20 mental health counseling and 5 career counseling). Demographics of our current students include 28 white, 4 black, 1 Hispanic, and 6 multi-racial. Of the admitted counselor education students, approximately 96% of graduated from the program within the expected 2-year time period. The job placement rate for graduates from this program is approximately 92.5%.

All counselor education majors must pass the *Counselor Preparation Comprehensive Examination* (CPCE). This national examination assesses skills and knowledge areas required to be a competent counselor. The pass rate our majors was 100% in 2016 and 100% in 2017. Moreover, our graduate students have consistently scored similarly to the national means in all areas assessed.
