2018 Counselor Education Program Outcomes

Currently 41 students are enrolled in the M.S./Ed.S. Counselor Education program at Florida State University. Of these, 33 students are majoring in Clinical Mental Health Counseling and 8 students are majoring in Career Counseling. During 2018, the program graduated 21 students (16 Clinical Mental Health Counseling students and 5 Career Counseling students). Demographic data for current students indicate that 23 are White, 4 Black, 9 Hispanic, 4 multiracial, and 1 nonresident alien. Of the counselor-education students admitted in 2016, 94.5% graduated from the program within the expected two year time period. The job placement rate for students graduated 2018 is approximately 77.5% (one student graduated 2018 was not able to seek a job due to personal health issues, and four students failed to reply to the alumni survey).

All counselor-education majors must pass the *Counselor Preparation Comprehensive Examination* (CPCE). This national examination assesses skills and knowledge areas required to be a competent counselor. The pass rates of our majors were 100% in both 2017 and 2018. Moreover, our graduate students have consistently scored higher than, or similarly to, the national means in all areas assessed.

^{*}One student took an approved leave of absence in the fall semester of 2017. She returned in the fall semester of 2018, and plans to graduate in the spring semester of 2019.

^{**}Four students failed to respond to the alumni survey; they may have found employment but are counted as unemployed due to nonresponse.
