## What Makes Us Unique

FSU's online EdD in Educational Leadership and Policy is a CPEDinspired doctorate of education, which provides working professionals with a supportive environment to expand their capacity to address the most pressing problems in education.



### FLEXIBILITY & INTENTIONALITY

Our classes are offered online and asynchronously, meaning "attendance" is not required at specific times. The curriculum is structured to help you meet milestone requirements and build your dissertation as you progress through the coursework. You will also have regular opportunities to meet synchronously with program faculty, course instructors, and your peers.

### STUDENT SUPPORT

As an EdD student, you will have access to faculty who are leaders in their fields, plus a host of other resources to support your leadership and learning. These include a student advising coordinator, major professor, targeted writing support, and peer connections via our cohort model. You will also have the opportunity to join us each June in Tallahassee for our annual Summer Institute!



**120** students are currently enrolled in the program, spanning across 4 cohorts.


All students engage in research to improve educational practice in their local contexts.


29% of current students have a research topic with an explicit focus on equity

### JULIE PERRY (COHORT 8)

Teacher, Computer Science Florida State University Schools

In collaboration with the Florida Department of Education, Julie Perry was chosen to serve on the committee tasked with writing the new Computer Science (CS) standards for Florida's schools. 
