Measurement and Statistics Engagement Policy

Doctoral students in Measurement and Statistics (M&S) can meet the Scholarly Engagement requirement by fulfilling either items 1 and 2, OR items 1 and 3, shown below.

- (1) Doctoral students should attend the bi-weekly M&S colloquia meeting unless an excused absence is provided. Excused absences include documented illness, deaths in the immediate family and other documented crises, call to active military duty or jury duty, religious holy days, and official University activities.
- (2) Doctoral students in the first two years of study should attend a professional conference (e.g., American Educational Research Association, American Psychological Association, American Statistical Association, or Florida Educational Research Association) that is related to their program of study. Doctoral students in their third year of study and beyond should give one or more presentation(s) related to their program of study, such as being an (co)-author in a professional conference.
- (3) Doctoral students should be involved in preparing, submitting, or publishing research paper(s) to scholarly outlets (e.g., journals, books) as authors or coauthors.
