

COE Faculty Research Grant Competition
Fall 2018

This semester (Fall 2018), so as to provide support and incentive for faculty who are not currently serving as a PI on an external grant, the COE Office of Research will be sponsoring a COE Faculty Research Grant Competition that, in conjunction with two of the grant programs offered by the FSU Council for Research and Creativity (CRC), will provide each of two faculty members with \$20,000 to support their research efforts. In order for you to be considered for one of these two College of Education Research Grants, you will need to submit a [Planning Grant proposal](#) or a [COFRS Grant proposal](#) to the CRC this semester.

Those COE faculty whose proposals are funded by the CRC and who are not currently serving as a PI on an external grant will be considered for receiving a COE Faculty Research Grant, ranging between \$6,000–\$7,000, from the COE Office of Research so that their total grant award will be \$20,000 (with the remainder coming from their CRC grant). A committee of COE faculty will examine the funded CRC proposals and will identify which two COE faculty will receive a COE Faculty Research Grant, with the primary criterion being the likelihood that the proposed research will eventually lead to a successful external grant proposal. Recipients of a COE Faculty Research Grant will be required to submit an external grant proposal through the COE Office of Research during the 2019–2020 academic year.

This semester, Planning Grant proposals are due October 11, and COFRS Grant proposals are due December 13.
